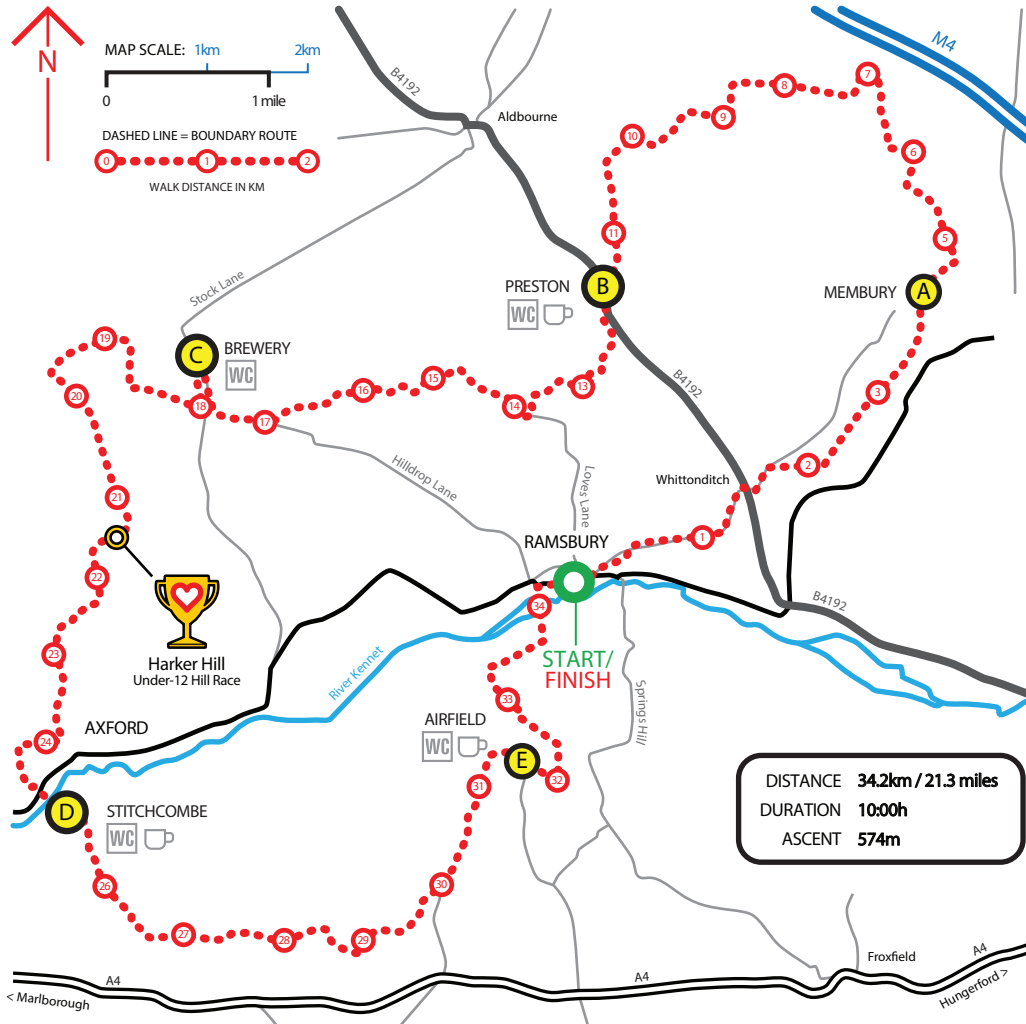

<b>START</b> MEMBURY A → B	--	07:30	08:35	Start walking from The Square. Keep your eyes open for cars to Whittonditch and deer herds across Eastridge.	<b>4km</b> 2.5 miles
<b>MEMBURY</b> PRESTON B → C	--	08:45	10:20	Rolling countryside, great views, the roar of the M4 and through Membury Fort. Bacon Sandwiches and Tea	<b>8km</b> 5 miles
<b>PRESTON</b> BREWERY C → D	10:25	10:45	12:35	Initial steep climb. Good walking through open countryside and two woods. Picnic lunch at Ramsbury Brewery	<b>6km</b> 3.7 miles
<b>BREWERY</b> STITCHCOMBE D → E	12:25	13:10	14:55	Section contains 2 steep hills. Otherwise good walking with great, open views. Squash and Biscuits	<b>7km</b> 4.3 miles
<b>STITCHCOMBE</b> AIRFIELD E → F	14:40	15:15	17:10	Gentle climb, then difficult but rewarding walking through Bluebell woods across private land. Cakes and Tea	<b>6.5km</b> 4 miles
<b>AIRFIELD</b> FINISH F → G	17:00	17:30	18:10	Pass WWII Memorial and take in the finest view of Ramsbury upon descent into village. Finish at Ramsbury British Legion	<b>3km</b> 1.8 miles

WALK GUIDELINES

To reduce our Boundary Walk's environmental impact, we will no longer be providing single use water bottles or cups for hot drinks. Please bring along your own bottles or flasks and refills will be provided at each stop.

- 01 Sorry, **NO DOGS**.
- 02 Dress appropriately: stout shoes or boots, waterproof clothing and/or a hat and sunscreen.
- 03 Don't overtake the Leader. If he/she asks you to stop, please do so. Keep to the paths and stay together.
- 04 If you have a problem, speak to the Leader or the Back Marker. They will be carrying a first aid kit and water.
- 05 You need to be reasonably fit to walk the whole route or the longer sections. If anyone is struggling or feeling unwell we may ask them to drop out so as not to hold up the rest of the walkers. Don't worry - we will get you back to The Square!
- 06 The Boundary Walk is always popular with children, but all walkers 12 and under must have a responsible adult with them at all times. If the responsible adult drops out of the walk at any stage, all children for whom that adult is responsible must also drop out. The Leader and the Back Marker cannot be the responsible adult.
- 07 Please bring your own lunch and make sure you're carrying enough snacks and drink for the walk.
- 08 Picnic lunches can be left in one of the designated cars in The Square and will be taken to the lunch stop; but don't leave in the Flyer, or you may never see your lunch again!
- 09 For your safety and the enjoyment of your fellow walkers, **PLEASE DO NOT LISTEN TO MUSIC**.
- 10 Any lost property will held at the Post Office. Unclaimed property will be disposed of after 3 months.
